



## Ashanti Farm Pothole Restoration

The path to the barn was a bumpy ride for farm owner Manfred Nettek. Even after several attempts to repair the private road with conventional methods, the potholes were still in desperate need of restoration. Global Manhole Restoration & Service Company LLC (GMRS) performed the repairs quickly in one short afternoon without much interruption to the ongoing business on the farm.

The job was performed with a small roller and a hand tamper by only two workers. While traditional hot asphalt was used in the construction of the road and in several unsuccessful attempts to repair it, GMRS used its proven cold asphalt product, Rephalt.

Rephalt was placed on the existing asphalt road at a thickness of 2 to 6 inches for this application. The overlay was compacted with a Wacker RD12-90 Roller and a hand tamper to smooth out the edges in the transition areas. The repaired sections are now leveling out the road and are holding up excellent under continuous use.
