

This step-by-step illustration demonstrates the benefits of our environmentally friendly Rust Primer ARP 662 SG. ARP has many applications in marine, automotive, and household areas.



In this photo series an engine starter for a tractor is restored with ARP 662 SG. The surface was prepared by degreasing and cleaning of the degreased surface with fresh water. Degreasing is an important part of preparation process as results can be impacted by any grease left on the metal surface.



A high pressure treatment is not needed to make the surface ready to accept primer. Removal of grease as well as loose rust is sufficient. The second photo shows the application process. APR 662 SG is applied to any metal surface simply by brushing or spraying on.



The final result: the engine starter is completely covered with ARP 662 SG. Its metal surface is protected against rust and corrosion for a long time until additional treatments will become necessary. No overcoat is necessary for this application.
